

**THE FINDINGS OF
“Know Thyself: The 2002 Ahepa Membership Survey**

Your feedback will help the future of the Order of Ahepa. The purpose of this first National Ahepa Member Survey is to gain feedback from you the members to ensure that our Order is the organization you want it to be.

The following represents the 611 completed questionnaires mailed in by June 2002. We have gained much information from the survey, but most of all it is an attempt to increase the direct participation of our membership into the affairs of the Order. The findings will help the Supreme Lodge in the future to help us both refine and redefine our Order. Thank you for your time and interest in completing the form.

The survey asked all members to evaluate each question on a scale of 1 to 5. 5= Strongly Agree down to 1= Strongly Disagree. The findings are simplified here into three categories for reporting purposes. “No Response” was noted an average of 3 to 7 %.

- 1. AGREE: Response “4” & “5” on the Survey.**
- 2. STATUS QUO/NEUTRAL: Response “3” on the survey.**
- 3. DISAGREE: Response “1” and “2” on the survey.**
